# Number Sense: Multiplying by 2-Digit Numbers 

Dear Family,

Your child is learning how to multiply larger numbers. He or she is also learning to estimate the answer to problems such as $17 \times 28$ by rounding 17 to 20 and 28 to 30 . By using estimation in the course of everyday experiences and family activities, you can help your child understand estimation. Here are two activities you can try.

## Shopping

Help your child understand that, when shopping, he or she can use estimation to figure out how much an item will cost. For example, if T-shirts cost $\$ 12$ each, have your child estimate the cost of 4 T-shirts.

## Target Game

Materials: paper and pencil
Step 1 Players pick a 3-digit number, such as 500, as a target number.

Step 2 Each player then picks a 2-digit number, such as 16 or 18 , as a playing number.

Step 3 Both players estimate the number that their playing number must be multiplied by for the product to be 500 (the target number).

Step 4 Use paper and pencil to find the exact product. The one who comes closest to 500 wins.
